He will let us know when they are ready by E Mail. Ratermann starts there was a Pension Board meeting and member S. Olish states that the system had an 11 percent increase in monies made. And the City is still trying to take over.. Also the law suit is still going on slow but sure.

Ratermann states he talked to Lawyer Elkins a while back and he stated that both sides read the decision and agreed and signed the agreement. Ratermann adds we have some sick members K.
