### Minutes of the June 8, 2011, SLPVA Meeting

The 392<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the St Louis Police Veterans' Association was called to order at 11:35 AM by President George Ratermann.

Chaplain Vincent Smugula led the members in an opening prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance. Smugula informed the members of a Mass to be celebrated at St Agatha's on June 18<sup>th</sup> at 4:30 PM for retired members of the SLMPD both living and deceased. St Agatha's is located at 3239 S. 9<sup>th</sup> at Utah, just south of the AB brewery. Everyone is invited to attend.

All officers of the SLPVA were present with the exception of Secretary Chris Zarbo. Trustees Anthony Pona and John Folluo were also present.

Ratermann read 4 applications for membership, Ron Klein, Craig Longworth, Michael Welby and Harvey Burnett. A motion was made and seconded to approve the 4 new members and the motion passed on a voice vote.

Ratermann introduced Jeff Roorda who addressed the members on the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the SLPOA and the SLMPD, the SLPOA's position as the exclusive bargaining agent, City Control legislation, the initiative petition on City Control, possibility of a Special Session of the Legislature, and Police Pension legislation that died at the end of the session.

When Ratermann began the reading the minutes of the May 11<sup>th</sup> 2011 meeting a motion was made from the floor to approve the minutes as printed. The Motion received a second and then was approved on a voice vote.

Treasurer Ed Vaclavik presented the treasurer's report and the bills for the month. A motion was made and seconded to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion passed on a voice vote.

Ratermann reported the deaths of Lawrence King, Thomas Picard, Louis Rizzuti, Curry Duke, and Isaac Steenberger.

Unfinished Business: Ratermann reminded members that Jim Chapman, the Will Guy, will be at the July 14<sup>th</sup> meeting and will assist members and spouses in preparing wills after the meeting.
